Absentee Ballots

- Must be received by County Clerk by 7pm Nov 3rd
- Before returning be sure to sign the envelope (under the flap) and include last 4 digits of SSN
- Anyone from any precinct can drop off a complete absentee ballot at any
 of the drop box locations and hours above. A spouse or close relative
 can also drop off an absentee ballot if they fill in the form on the return
 envelope including their name and relationship to the voter.
- If you can, drop off your ballot in a drop-box rather than mailing.
- If you've already mailed a ballot and it is returned to you, you must take it
 to a ballot drop box rather than putting it back into the mail (this could
 happen because of a bar code problem and your ballot goes to ABQ for
 sorting)
