HB206, the Utility Affordability and Relief Act, will be heard on the House floor as early as tomorrow!

This critical piece of legislation, sponsored by Reps. Ortez, Romero, Ferrary, and Rubio, aims to help thousands of New Mexico families who have fallen behind on their utility bills during the COVID–19 pandemic. This bill is headed to the full House of Representatives any time now. **We need help reaching legislators to encourage them to support this bill!**

Tens of thousands of New Mexico families face disconnection from electricity, gas and water services. HB 206 not only takes steps to protect these families from immediate disconnection, but it also provides long-term solutions related to energy affordability in our state. The following provisions are in the bill, including:

- Providing immediate protections including prohibiting disconnections
 for low-income and otherwise needy customers, requiring utilities to seek
 federal funding and leverage other funds and contributions to help
 customers, directing utilities to provide payment plans and upon
 completion of the payment plan, offering these customers a partial
 forgiveness of arrears that can be recovered by utilities in future rate
 cases.
- Providing long-term solutions related to energy affordability including mechanisms to increase energy efficiency

Development Block Grant program that would fund energy efficiency projects and programs throughout our state.

This legislation will be heard any time now on the floor of the N.M.

House. Please tell your own representative how important this bill is and ask them to support it.
