
As part of our support for Gabe Vasquez in our southern congressional district, we have committed to do 900 postcards. <u>BlueCD2</u> is an awesome PAC that helped to re-elect Gabe for the 2nd time in a tight district. Carol and Dianne volunteering to assist Diane with distributions. (**THANK YOU!**) An email going out to recruit volunteers for packets of 25 (a couple of hours work, max) Each volunteer expected to provide postage for their cards, but help is available if

this is a problem). Instructions are attached, with an interesting assessment of the impact that these postcards had in 2024.

EVENTS and PROJECTS:

- -Tiny Signs were discussed using popsicle sticks with messages to place in strategic places. Zines are small booklets folded from a single sheet of paper that can address any topic. Some ideas are cartoons, quotations, facts and figures, etc. (DO be mindful of copyright and give artists credit for their work.) https://sarahbush.substack.com/
- -The new Blue Bus building will have a ribbon cutting on June 28 from 11 a.m.- 2 p.m. and it might a good opportunity for us.
- -Transgender Identities & Health forum at SOMOS on June 29 from 2-3:30 p.m. (Special plea: Winston has had his posters pulled down all over town, and the Taos News has

refused to include this event. I can assure you – you will learn something. Please attend!)



Diane is looking for data concerning effects of budget cuts directly affecting New Mexicans and Ellen will research some about it; Marjorie mentioned that 15 rural hospitals in New Mexico may have to close due to Medicaid cuts alone and that \$3 billion will be lost for CD3 alone (house version and senate version is worse); Diane will attempt to get a list of cuts from our congressional delegation.

Wise Fools group in Penasco does the big Puppets and there will be a workshop there soon which would be a great group activity; she is planning a "Weeping Statue of Liberty" puppet which would require maybe 3-4 people to handle; will have to determine how to maneuver within our protest space; Caroline will have a smaller, one person, puppet ready for the July 4th protest.

Questions/Other Issues:

Maybe a march in Taos - police chief has been contacted but no response yet.

Maybe have some sit ins, die ins, teach ins.

Discussions around Public Land sales and the major blowbacks. UPDATE: Looks like the Public Land sales, at least, have been removed from the Senate Bill.

Spreading the word by maybe having yard signs, flyers on bulletin boards, using social media.

Marjorie mentioned she is on a Signal group for any ICE sightings in Taos as some questioned the need.

Maybe the need to tell individual stories of arrests/kidnappings by ICE and "<u>Disappeared in America</u>" was mentioned. (This site is SO Powerful. I would like to do a photo show/exhibit if there's enthusiasm for it.)

Discussion around the Democrats who voted for or to table the trump Impeachment Article.
